We sincerely thank you for choosing Saint Mark's Coptic Orthodox College as a partner in your child's educational journey. Our students are the heart of our mission, and we remain committed to providing them with the strongest foundation for future success.

As an independent school, we rely on tuition fees to bridge the gap between government funding and the actual cost of delivering high-quality education. Saint Mark's continues to maintain modest fee increases, ensuring we remain a low-fee independent school while meeting Federal Government Recurrent Funding requirements.

What Your Fees Include

Your College fees represent real value, covering a wide range of educational resources and opportunities, such as:

- Software subscriptions and online learning platforms
- Classroom tuition, materials, and stationery
- Chromebooks and iPads for Primary classes
- Textbooks and academic resources
- Support and enrichment teachers, including learning support programs
- Academic competitions (e.g., debating)
- Interhouse and interschool sports, swimming, and gymnastics
- Library resources
- Excursions, incursions, and compulsory camps
- Elective subject fees

Please note: uniforms are not included in College fees.

ENROLMENT FEES

- \$220 per application
- Bond \$750 per family - is returned to the family upon a student's graduation or if enrolment is terminated by the parents with notice of a least one full term.
- Fees in Advance \$750 per Primary student; \$1,250 per Secondary student.

SIBLING DISCOUNT

To assist families with multiple children enrolled:

1. First Child - full fee paying
2. Second Child- Tuition Fees 20% discount on tuition fees
3. Third Child – Tuition fees 35% discount on tuition fees
4. Fourth Child onwards- Exempt from Tuition Fees

PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Option 1: General Payment Schedule:

Equal Instalments must be paid on or before the following dates:

First Instalment	Second Instalment	Third Instalment
4 March 2026	2 June 2026	14 August 2026

Option 2: Early Payment:

- **8% discount (Tuition Fee only)** on full payment of the invoice if payment is made by 4 March 2026. Please note there is no flexibility on this date.

Option 3: Payment Plan:

Flexible plans are available. Please contact the Finance Office for details.

UNPAID FEES

If fees are not paid by the due date(s):

- Late Payment penalty will apply.
- Outstanding debts may be referred to external collection agencies.
- Legal action may be taken.
- The Head of College may suspend or terminate the student’s enrolment.

STUDENT WITHDRAWAL

Parents/Guardians must give one term’s written notice (letter or email) to withdraw a student. Failure to do so will result in one term’s fees being charged and forfeiture of the bond refund.
